

OSHN Ltd Students on Placement Policy

Students / young people who attend the setting on work placements will be supported by a full risk assessment from their school / college to ensure that TOSH is a suitable place for them to attend, this will be deemed as a Reference, and will be taken from schools / colleges to ensure the suitability of any student who applies to attend at this setting.

A written and formal agreement will be sought from schools / colleges to ensure that they have undertaken suitability checks on any students who request to work with young children.

Public liability insurance is held by T.O.S.H. which covers student and young children under the age of 19 being in attendance at the setting on work placement or in ratio's with their parents/carers.

Student safety when they are on placement at the setting will be taken seriously and a full risk assessment of potential dangers is undertaken. Students will be fully inducted in relation to Safeguarding and Whistle Blowing to ensure that they are fully prepared in the event that a child should make a disclosure to them.

Students will never be left alone with any child or group of children and this will be ensured by our policy of never having just one person in any room.

Students will not be involved or included in any personal hygiene and **MAY NOT** go into toilets with the children.

Students will be supervised by a senior staff member at all times.
