

Sun Care Policy:

Written August 2018

Parents must provide their children with a clearly named sun hat.

During sunny weather, children may not play outside unless they are wearing a sun hat. (some spares are available for emergencies).

Parents must also provide their children with their own clearly named sun cream, which should be handed to a staff member, who will store it safely ready for use.

During hot weather, children should wear light weight clothing, if necessary staff will remove / change clothing to ensure children are comfortable.

Children will not play outside in direct sunlight between the hours of 11a.m. and 2.30 p.m.

Children who stay all day at nursery (6 p.m) will have sun cream reapplied after lunch.

Parents are required to apply sun screen to their children before they come to nursery to afford protection during the morning.

All children have access to water throughout the day. Babies and toddlers also have access to their drinks throughout the day.
